- vigilance is needed (students' other activities: gang, outsiders intrusion, drinking, smoking, doping)
 - be vigilant with what group your students are organizing; call the parents for dialogue; give the students the appropriate assistance to know what is proper and what is improper; always refer to legal bases; refer to the students' handbook; refer to anti-bullying act; refer to child protection policy, children's rights, human rights
 - let us read about these legal bases, so we will be much aware and well-guided on what to do
 - remind advisees of the purpose of the bail (for social development, camaraderie and total personality enhancement)
7. On academic performance of students
- alarming percentage of failures is noted, since 2nd quarter until 3rd quarter
 - the number increases, seemingly no remediation or intervention is working
 - only one quarter is left, hence all teachers, subject teachers and advisers alike are requested to collaborate with one another to address the problem
 - remember: deficiencies in the 1st quarter should have been addressed within the 2nd quarter. The trend of failure should have been decreasing, not increasing
 - let us revisit our strategies, our methodologies, our teaching styles, and check whether they complement our STUDENTS' learning styles
8. SHS Tour
- as the mission goes: Teachers FACILITATE learning and NURTURE every learner"
 - Grade 9 and 10 students (1:30 PM) with their advisers
 - Grade 7 and 8 students (2:30 PM) with their advisers
 - Students who could not join should stay in school to be taken charge by teachers who will be left in school, perform some practical activities related to the SHS Program (they will tour the school campus)
 - Attendance of participants should be accounted properly.
 - Safety and security should be at the top priority at all times
 - Proper orientation on discipline and decorum should be conducted beforehand
 - Questions relative to what they learned during the tour should be one of the outputs of students, to be collected by the advisers and forwarded to the SHS Coordinator
 - Class advisers are responsible for their class advisees
9. Other matters
- students' discipline is of utmost importance...let us be their guide
 - link with their families, as necessary as possible
 - "never leave a single stone unturned" LOOK for the LEAST, LOST and LAST in your class
